



The Spanish Cytology Society (SEC) has been accredited with ISO 17043. ENAC has granted accreditation to the Q-Pap Program for Quality Control in Gynaecological Cytology (Q-Pap Morphological and Q-Pap Molecular).



The SEC is currently the only accredited European Cytology Scientific Society accredited to perform intercomparison exercises, adjusted to the requirements of cancer screening pro-cervical programmes.

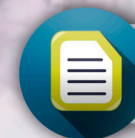
